Run sheet

12.00 -12.15 lunch eating – state over mic “rubbish in bin.” “Bags to gym’

12.15 – 12.35 – play time

12.35-12.45 – toilet/find teacher etc

12.50 – 1.10 – R-3

1.15 -1.35 – Yr 4-7

1.40 - 1.55 – adults/teachers (15min)

1.55 – finish – clean up, rubbish in bins

2:05— students released from oval

Picnic—in class groups on the oval. Families can have their child sit with them in the 2 designated parent areas. Families not to cross to the oval area in this time.

Parent Areas—COVID Marshalls to patrol 2 areas (Lisa and Kate)

QR Code posters will be displayed along office wall facing courts and on the shed wall near toilet block. At this point there will be sign in sheets for SA Health as well as sanitiser available.

Class Assemble—Students to bring bags to the gym where cones with class numbers will be displayed for placement. (No students back inside classrooms) Drink bottles to be in a crate on the oval for access during the afternoon. Sun block may be required as well.

First Aid and adult colour run participation payments can be made to the girls in the office. Or prior on QKR—closes 5pm Thursday.

Running track—2 different courses (R-30 and (4-7)

Students will be running through the parents stationed areas; a 2m wide track will be marked with cones for families to stay behind. They can run/walk/jog around as many times in the time frame as they like. Around 250g of 7 x different coloured powders has been allocated per participant.

Colour Stations— the school marquees will be set up at each station with staff, students and designated parent helpers to squirt the coloured powder at students.
