We had 40 family responses with consensus that most families like the uniform's logo, colours and design. Most families indicated they would be happy to pay a bit more money for quality, long-wearing fabrics.

Some people asked for a softer material for the polo top and a spray jacket to be included. There was an indication of a school jumper to include a hoodie and a dress option.

Out of 157 student responses from Reception to Year 5, just over half indicated they liked the uniform but would like more colour, a newer, modern design and a new logo. The students indicated the polo is itchy and asked if they could have a different fabric and possibly a different style hat.

We will now take all this information into consideration when tackling our next steps in the uniform update process.
